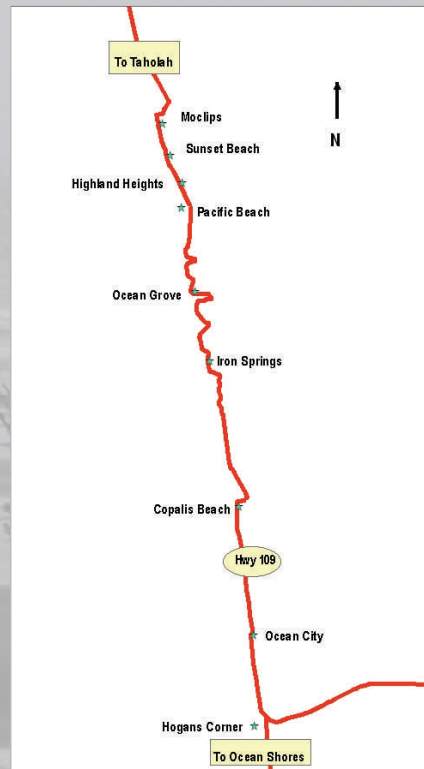

Look what we've done now.....

North Beach Community Improvement Association (NBCIA) has been busy. Since 2006 we've:

- Adopted a stretch of Highway 109, by volunteering to keep it clean and litter free
- Partnered with Grays Harbor County and Washington State Parks for a new Conner Creek bridge for better access
- Succeeded in petitioning Grays Harbor County for the removal of the old Johnson Mercantile, a long-abandoned, hazardous building
- Worked with Grays Harbor County on community safety resulting in 2 resident law officers now living within our North Beach communities

HOME OF THE GHOST FOREST

Ghost Forest

The North Beach Communities are host to Washington's unique Ghost Forest. Accessible only by non-motorize vessel, the Ghost Forest is a remnant of a forest killed in 1700 by a powerful tsunami originating from an earthquake off the coast. The trees were killed by the rapid inflow of mud and water as the land subsided, leaving a forest of ghostly trees still standing 300 years later.

Ghost Forest Park?

Working with Washington State Parks, NBCIA is actively promoting the preservation of our unique Ghost Forest. Currently privately owned, Washington State Parks is exploring options to acquire the Ghost Forest for all State residents to enjoy.
